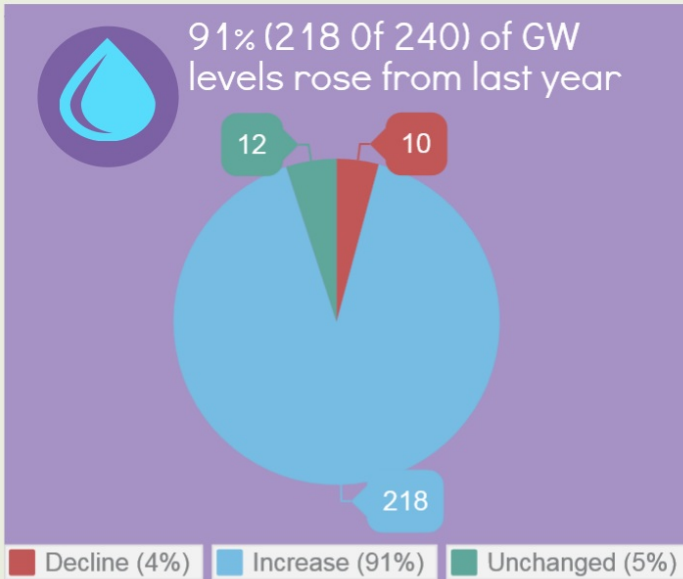

SPRING 2015 GROUNDWATER LEVEL REPORT



Spring Groundwater Levels

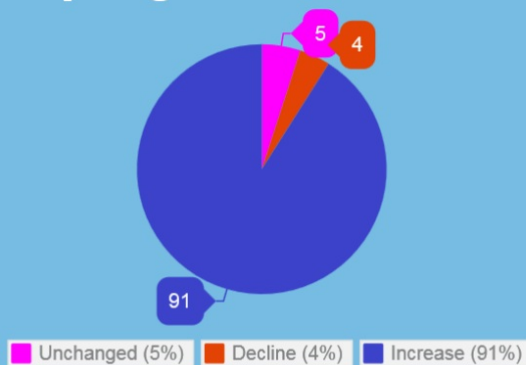
- 12 wells had a change of .2 to -.2, and are viewed as unchanged.

Of the 240 wells that rose:

- 126 wells rose from 0.20' to 2.00'
- 65 wells rose from 2.01' to 4.00'
- 17 wells rose from 4.01' to 6.00'
- 10 wells rose > 6.00'

Compares to 104 wells in 2014, and 3 wells in 2013.

4% (10 of 240) of GW levels showed a decline from last spring



Groundwater Level Declines

- Wells that have a change of .2 to -.2 are viewed as unchanged.
- All 10 wells showed a decline of less than 2.00'.
- Compares to 136 wells in 2014, and 242 wells in 2013.

Historic Lows



1 well recorded lowest spring reading ever

- This compares to 8 wells in 2014, and 45 wells in 2013.
